



Volunteers In Service Standards Operating Procedures
Volunteer Guidelines
Effective June 4, 2020

Thank you for allowing God to use you in such a specific way during the COVID-19 pandemic. During this pandemic VIS would like you to follow some basic guidelines which will protect both VIS friends and you.

1. We ask every volunteer to follow the COVID-19 contact guidelines - Anyone (Volunteer or VIS friend) who meets any of the criteria below should refrain from meeting or providing services until they no longer exhibit the criteria.
 - a. *Returned from, or connected through, any of the following areas within the last 14 days. China, South Korea, Iran, Japan, Italy.*
 - b. *Been diagnosed or been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed or has been in contact with someone who may have been exposed with COVID-19 June 4 within the last 14 days.*
 - c. *Have experienced any cold or flu like symptoms, including fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, difficulty breathing within the last 14 days.*
2. Please observe the 6 foot space limitations **at all times**. Please use good hygiene. i.e. washing hands and cart etc. Sanitize hands whenever possible. Since the governor and president are recommending, VIS strongly recommends wearing a facemask. *If you do not have a mask, VIS will provide one for you. Pickup at Providence CRC - 7730 Eastern Avenue SE at Door "D" (south side door). There will be a container labeled VIS Volunteers with masks in it.*
3. If you are interacting with VIS Friends, the governor, CDC and VIS strongly recommend both the VIS Friend and you wear a mask. If the VIS Friend or you do not have a mask, VIS will provide one.
4. When traveling with a VIS Friend in a car, please remember the 6ft restrictions and wearing a mask. Suggestion: have the VIS Friend ride in the backseat on the far right side.
5. VIS recommends you use wipes and spray sanitizer after traveling with a VIS Friend.
6. Please communicate with your VIS connections staff when the task is completed.
